



Q.1: How often do you receive feedback on your teaching?




Favorable: 41%





Q.1: Overall, how much do you learn about teaching from the leaders at your school?









Q.1: On most days, how enthusiastic are the students about being at school?





Q.2: When new initiatives to improve teaching are presented at your school, how supportive are your colleagues?





Q.3: How optimistic are you that your school will improve in the future?





Q.4: How supportive are students in their interactions with each other?






Q.6: How respectful are the relationships between teachers and students?





Q.1: How positive is the tone that school leaders set for the culture of the school?





Q.2: Overall, how positive is the influence of the school leaders on the quality of your teaching?





Q.3: How effectively do school leaders communicate important information to teachers?





Q.4: How knowledgeable are your school leaders about what is going on in teachers' classrooms?






Q.6: How clearly do your school leaders identify their goals for teachers?





Q.1: How confident are you that your school leaders have the best interests of the students in mind?





Q.2: How much trust exists between school leaders and faculty?





Q.3: When you face challenges at work, how supportive are your school leaders?











Q.1: How confident are you that you can move through material at a pace that works well for each of your students?





Q.2: How confident are you that you can help your school's most challenging students to learn?






Q.4: How confident are you that you can meet the learning needs of your most advanced students?


