
Program Opportunities



As part of this partnership, MVWSD commits to the following:

- Commit to agreed upon utilization to support feedback and evaluation
- Provide ongoing feedback for current products and features
- Completion of mid-year and year end survey and evaluation meetings
- Research A/B study with Castro School K-1 students compared to Theuerkauf School as the control group
 - This should include both pre and post assessments by MVWSD staff utilizing existing assessment tools within the district to evaluate student progress
- Participate in beta testing for future products and feature enhancements
- Participate on Advisory Panel, offering feedback to our End User Experience, Curriculum,
 Education Client Services, Product and Software teams to share ideas and suggestions regarding product roadmap

Data Collecting, Disclosure and Storage

- 1. Collection of Participant and Non-Participant Data.
 - a. Participant Defined. Any student who is selected based on the criteria set forth within the agreement and approved to participate in the Square Panda program shall become a participant upon submission of a signed program Release (each, a "Participant"). A student who has not submitted the Program Release cannot be considered a Participant. Instead, that student is considered a "Non-Participant".
 - b. Compliance with FERPA and applicable privacy laws. The Parties acknowledge that student-level data is critical to analysis of Program metrics. Mountain View Whisman School District (MVWSD) agrees to acquire parent/caregiver consent in compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA"} and any and all applicable state or local laws regarding educational rights and privacy from participants to share certain data between them. Confidential information includes, but is not limited to, the information in subsection 2 below.
 - c. Collection of Participant Data.

School agrees to provide the following participant-specific information to Square Panda:

- Data regarding classroom behavior and discipline
- Pre and post assessment Reading scores
- · Picture/Video release forms
- d. School Assistance with Data.

School also agrees to provide Square Panda reasonable access to School staff members familiar with the data for further assessment/analysis of the data.

2. Disclosure of Data.

a. Disclosure of Participant Data to Square Panda

Pursuant to Education Code § 49076(c) and 34 CFR § 99.31(b), School may share student records or information without the consent of the student's parent or guardian if the records or information are de-identified, which requires the removal of all personally identifiable information. School agrees that all Participant data, with personal identifiers removed (to the extent required by applicable law), may be shared with Square Panda for the purposes of analysis and program improvement.

MVWSD agrees that Square Panda may engage in analysis of the Program may report aggregate, de-identified, participant data analysis to the School, which may use them for purposes of improving instruction and the Program.

b. Disclosure to Third Parties


School understands that such data may be referenced in reports to funders, newsletters, or other publications related to the Program; however, no data from individual students that is not de-identified will be reported.

Neither Party shall disclose any findings or analysis from non-public data without prior written consent of the other party (and/or any Program Participant, as defined above, as appropriate), other than summary data that does not identify any individual person; such data may include expenditure patterns, and expenditure per pupil or category of pupil.

3. Protection and Security of Stored Data.

Square Panda agrees that, other than as necessary with respect to the Program, data will be kept confidential. Square Panda agrees to maintain appropriate network and other data security to protect any School student data in its possession. Square Panda agrees to notify School as soon as reasonably practicable if it has any reason to believe there has been a breach of data security relevant to the data subject to this Agreement, and any data has been lost, tampered with, or otherwise illegally accessed. All electronic data analysis will be performed on password-protected computers.

Square Panda shall maintain the confidentiality and safeguard the analysis of any data gathered as a result of this Agreement, and will not, without the prior consent of School, disclose any findings or analysis derived from non-public information other than: (a) summary data as set forth herein (b) data and analysis of such summary data used to promote the educational and research purposes of the Project or its implications for further work related to the Achievement Gap; (c) data and findings that have been made publicly available without breaching any of the MVWSD confidentiality obligations

Policy & Recording Consent Form for Square Panda Program

This notice is to communicate that your child is eligible to participate in a free program that will take place during your child's regular classroom and class time.
