Resolution No. 01-090618, Sufficiency of Pupil Textbooks and Instructional Materials Aligned to the Academic Content Standards and Consistent with Content and Cycles of State Frameworks

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of Mountain View Whisman School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 is required to hold a public hearing, which is on or before the eighth week of school, and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the Governing Board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the Mountain View Whisman School District; and

WHEREAS, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home; and

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, in mathematics, science, history-social science, and English/language arts, including the English language-development component of an adopted program, are aligned with to the content standards and are consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks; and

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in foreign language or health classes; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that for the 2018-2019 school year, the Mountain View Whisman School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
