

Boundaries communications and process:

- [Letters and emails](#) to all families (those who are moving and those who are not) on Wednesday 10/17 (both mail and email)
- Distributed [talking points](#) about the changes for use by principals and front office staff members.
- Principals talk staff on Wednesday about boundaries in general and that parents will be notified this week.
- Starting next Wednesday, Carmen and Ayindé will begin meetings at the sites to explain the staffing component and how boundaries will impact staffing. Bullis will also have an impact on these staffing plans, too.

The process for parent concerns:

1. Sites will answer general information and then, if needed, offer to take parents' contact information that will go to Student Services for followup.
2. If concerns still exist, parents have the option to fill out a student placement exemption form
3. For consistency and fairness, these forms will be reviewed by a committee of an administrator, a community and a board member.

Boundary changes talking points

What?

Next year, in the fall of 2019-20, kindergarten-4th grade students in transition neighborhoods or currently attending a school other than their neighborhood school may be attending new neighborhood schools, including the newly constructed Jose Antonio Vargas Elementary.

Why?

The Board of Trustees last spring approved new school boundaries, to be enacted next year/in the 2019-20 school year, to redistribute student enrollment among the District's elementary schools and facilitate students attending their neighborhood schools.

Who?

Only students currently in transitional kindergarten through third grade in affected neighborhoods will be impacted by a change in attendance area. Students at Mistral and Stevenson are not affected.

What are the exemptions?

- younger siblings of 2019-20 fifth-graders in these transition neighborhoods who have the option of staying at their current school for the 2019-20 year only
- students currently enrolled at Stevenson Elementary and Mistral Elementary.
- Children who want to attend a school that has excess capacity, parents may apply during open enrollment in January. Likely, the typically impacted neighborhood schools (Bubb, Huff and Landels) will not have available capacity next year. The District will be assessing capacity this spring and will offer school placement to these applicants in April, depending on space.

What do parents do now?

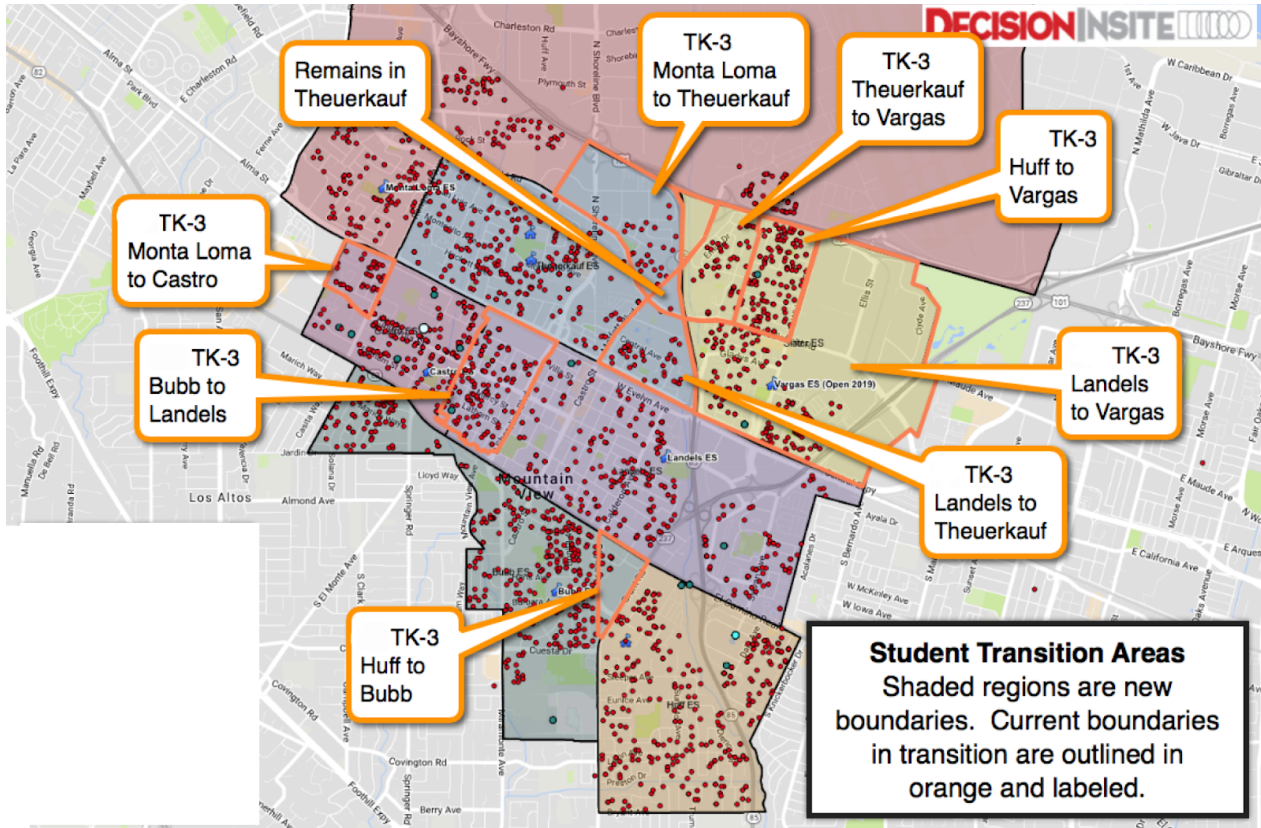
No action is required at this time. Please confirm your child's intent to enroll during the open enrollment process in January.

The Board of Trustees last spring approved new school boundaries, to be enacted next year/in the 2019-20 school year, to redistribute student enrollment among the District's elementary schools and facilitate students attending their neighborhood schools. Next year, in the fall of 2019-20, kindergarten-4th grade students in transition neighborhoods may be attending new neighborhood schools, including the newly constructed Jose Antonio Vargas Elementary.

Only students currently in transitional kindergarten through third grade in affected neighborhoods will be impacted by a change in attendance area. Students currently in grades 4-8 will not be affected.

Your residence is in an affected neighborhood. Your student, Jon xx, will be assigned this neighborhood school next year: Vargas Elementary School.

Exemptions:

- * If your child is currently enrolled in a choice program at Mistral Elementary or Stevenson Elementary, he/she will continue to be enrolled there.
- * If your current TK, kinder, first-, second-, or third-grader has a sibling who will be a fifth-grader in 2019–20, you may choose to have your younger child attend his/her current school **for the 2019-20 year only** with your fifth-grader. If this is your circumstance, look for a survey in December in which you can confirm your preference.
- * If you want your child to attend a school that has excess capacity, you may apply during open enrollment in January. Likely, the typically impacted neighborhood schools (Bubb, Huff and Landels) will not have available capacity next year. The District will be assessing capacity this spring and will offer school placement to these applicants in April, depending on space.

Excepciones:

- * Si su hijo está inscripto en una escuela de elección en la Escuela Primaria Mistral o en la Escuela Primaria Stevenson, seguirá inscripto/a en esa escuela.
- * Si su hijo está en Kínder de Transición, en Kínder o en los grados 1.º, 2.º o 3.º y tiene un hermano que estará en el 5.º grado en el ciclo 2019-20, puede enviar a su hijo menor a la escuela del hijo mayor, **solo durante el ciclo 2019-20**. Si se encuentra en esta circunstancia, en diciembre recibirá una encuesta en la cual podrá confirmar su preferencia.
- * Si desea que su hijo asista a una escuela con exceso de capacidad, puede solicitarlo durante la inscripción abierta en enero. Es probable que las escuelas de vecindario típicamente superpobladas (Bubb, Huff y Landels) no tengan plazas disponibles para el próximo año. El distrito evaluará la capacidad esta primavera y ofrecerá colocación a estas escuelas en abril, dependiendo del espacio.
