# AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO MOUNTAIN VIEW WHISMAN SCHOOL DISTRICT CONTRACT 2015-01 AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES (the "Second Amendment") is dated November \_\_\_\_, 2018 for reference only and is made by and between the Mountain View Whisman School District, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter called "DISTRICT," and Greystone West Company, a California corporation, hereinafter called "PROJECT MANAGER."

#### RECITALS

- A. WHEREAS, on or about June 25, 2015, the Board of Trustees of the DISTRICT (the "BOARD") approved the Mountain View Whisman School District Contract 2015-01 Agreement for Construction Project Management Services with PROJECT MANAGER for construction management services concerning Measure G bond projects (the "Project Manager Contract"); and
- B. WHEREAS, the BOARD voted and approved PROJECT MANAGER as its Measure G Construction manager; and
- C. WHEREAS, on February 24, 2017, the BOARD approved an amendment to the Project Manager Contract to include additional services to be performed by PROJECT MANAGER; and
- D. WHEREAS, the DISTRICT now desires to further amend the Project Manager Contract to include additional services to be performed by PROJECT MANAGER (the "Second Amendment").

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

#### **AGREEMENT**

- 1. <u>Description of Services.</u> Section 1 of the Program Manager Contract and Attachment A therein is amended to include within the description of services the additional projects described in Exhibit A to this Second Amendment ("Additional Projects").
- 2. <u>Contract Documents</u>. Section 3 of the Program Manager Contract is amended to include the Additional Projects.
- 3. <u>Compensation</u>. Section 4 of the Project Manager Contract and Attachment C referenced therein are amended to provide that full compensation for services provided by Project Manager for the Additional Projects shall be as set forth in Exhibit A to this Second Amendment and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 4. <u>Term of Amendment</u>: This Second Amendment is effective on the date all parties have fully executed this Second Amendment and the Board of Trustees of the DISTRICT has approved or ratified this Second Amendment.
- 5. <u>No Other Modification</u>. Except as expressly modified by this Second Amendment, all other provisions in the Project Manager Contract shall remain the same and in full force and effect.
- **6.** <u>Separate Counterparts</u>. This Second Amendment may be executed in separate counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original. Such counterparts shall, together, constitute and be one and the same instrument.
