

Wellness Topic #1: Middle School Start Times

Senate Bill No. 328

- Approved October 13, 2019
 - Requires all non-rural middle and high schools to start no earlier than 8:00 am (middle) and 8:30 am (high)
 - Law takes effect July 1, 2022
 - Middle schools start at 7:50 am (Graham) and
 7:55 am (Crittenden)
 - Issue was brought up by parents during the 2017-18 school year.



Research behind start times

Hanover conducted a meta-analysis

- American Academy of Pediatrics recommends
 - middle schools should not start earlier than 8:30
 am
- American Academy of Sleep Medicine recommends
 - children between the ages of 6 and 12 recieve between 9 and 12 hours (elementary)
- Appropriate start time for elementary school 7:30-8:30 am


Hanover continued...

- In 2015 Kentucky found that elementary schools experienced
 - modest correlations between start times and positive impact on student achievement for schools serving low number of Socioeconomic Disadvantaged (SED) Students
 - no impact on schools serving high need SED students
 - Positive outcome for behavioral outcomes for elementary students

Hanover continued...

- 2007 study found that students self-reported
 50 more minutes of sleep, by moving school time from 7:15 to 8:37 am
- 2012 study in Wake County found that delaying start times from 7:30 to 8:30 yielded
 - 1% percentile increase in ELA scores
 - 2% percentile increase in Math scores
