MVWSD Dashboard

- During the 2015-16 school year MVWSD Trustees approved Strategic Plan 2021 (SP2021)
 - One MVWSD, One Team, One Plan
 - Five-year plan to improve student outcomes for all students.
- In addition to SP2021, each year the MVWSD Trustees develop yearly goals that outline important initiatives.

MVWSD Dashboard

The Dashboard is an at-a-glance accountability measure to help staff, Trustees and the public monitor

- The progress of yearly SP2021 action items (initiatives)
- The progress of annual goals that are set by the MVWSD Trustees

SP2021 goals use battery icons to denote progress

Understanding the Dashboard

Trustees' goals use light bulbs to show progress

Status	Action
	During the 2017-18 school year, revise the ELL program to ensure that a minimum of 80% of students who are enrolled in the program will reach competency in the English language on par with their peers within a six-year period.
	By the end of the 2017-18 school year, expand the Response to Instruction (RTI) program so that it serves all students in all elementary schools.
	By the end of the 2017-18 school year, modify the middle school schedule to ensure that all students will have an opportunity to engage



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Monitoring

Monitoring

- Staff review and discuss the progress toward goals monthly
- The Dashboard will be updated for the public after the conclusion of every Trustee retreat
 - Next update will take place during April retreat
- In the event that an item is identified as RED, a remediation plan is developed to get the action item back on track
- SP2021 is adjusted annually



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Board Goal 1 - English Language Learners

EL Board Goal 1--Why Change?

- The focus on Board Goal 1 in year two led us to uncover issues that needed to be addressed in order to ensure success for all English Learners.
- Create a goal that captures an English learner's whole experience with the MVWSD instructional program--all elements of instruction working in concert rather than isolation (e.g., RTI, SIOP, ELD, Progress Monitoring)
- Modify Board Goal 1 to focus on reclassification rather than just proficiency on the ELPAC.

New Goal

During the 2019-20 school year, use a cohort model and follow students entering in Kindergarten each year beginning in 2017-18 (first year of ELPAC).

- By the end of 5th grade 75% of English Learners who entered MVWSD in Kindergarten will be reclassified.
- By the end of 8th grade 85% of English Learners who entered MVWSD in Kindergarten will be reclassified.



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Cohorts

Establishing Cohorts

Method

- Established annually
- Includes English Learner students who enter in Kindergarten and are continuously enrolled in MVWSD
- Defined by year of exit
 - Kindergarteners this year are the 2028 cohort
- Current grades K-2 only, cohorts 2028, 2027, and 2026, are measured formally for Board Goal 1 although we are reporting progress for all grade levels

Option 3: Response to Instruction Model

In partnership with Science is Elementary and Discovery Education, RTI teachers would be trained in NGSS by Discovery Education and all other teachers will receive training from SIE.

Description: Engaging science instruction using updated materials is delivered at a minimum of 2 days per week by science expert (RTI) teachers.
