Our emotions are real, and recent events have heightened them significantly. We have new roles, new demands, and new needs. We have felt fear, sadness, and grief; but we have also worked hard to maintain hope and focus on what really matters. Attendees will gain a deeper understanding of social and emotional learning (SEL) and connect to the importance of SEL for ourselves, our students, our families, and community. Then using the EMM approach of I Matter, You Matter, and We Matter, attendees will practice how they can use these lenses to develop SEL and reflect on how we can all be even better, both individually and collectively. Attendees will leave with greater awareness of SEL and gather tools and resources to apply these concepts with students, families, and the community.
