BOC's Role

The Scope of the BOC

- Pursuant to Section 15278 of the Education Code, the District established an "independent citizens' oversight committee" to satisfy the accountability requirements of Proposition 39.
- Given that the expenditure of Measure G bond funds was nearly complete, through Board Resolution No. <u>01-060420</u> the Board discontinued the Measure G CBOC to establish a citizens' oversight committee to oversee the expenditure of remaining Measure G and Measure T bond funds
- The Committee shall actively review and report on the proper expenditure of taxpayers' money for school construction, and advise the public as to whether the District is in compliance.

The Scope of the BOC

The Committee shall convene to provide oversight for, but not limited to, the following:

- Ensuring that Measure G and Measure T bond proceeds are expended only for the purposes described in paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Section 1 of Article XIII A of the California Constitution.
- Ensuring that Measure G and Measure T bond proceeds are not used for any teacher or administrative salaries or other school operating expenses, unless permitted by applicable law.
