Purpose: Resolution No. 02-012623 Intent to Offer or Expand Full-Day Transitional Kindergarten and/or Kindergarten, and Authorizing Projects and Filing of Applications for Funding under the California Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten and Full-Day Kindergarten Facilities Grant Program.

WHEREAS, the Mountain View Whisman School District intends to offer or expand enrollment in a full-day kindergarten and/or transitional kindergarten program at any or all of the following school sites: Amy Imai Elementary, Benjamin Bubb Elementary, Edith Landels Elementary, Gabriela Mistral Elementary, Jose Antonio Vargas Elementary, Mariano Castro Elementary, Monta Loma Elementary, Stevenson Elementary and Theuerkauf Elementary and;

WHEREAS, the Mountain View Whisman School District intends to offer or expand enrollment in a full-day kindergarten and/or kindergarten program at any or all of the following school sites: Amy Imai Elementary, Benjamin Bubb Elementary, Edith Landels Elementary, Gabriela Mistral Elementary, Jose Antonio Vargas Elementary, Mariano Castro Elementary, Monta Loma Elementary, Stevenson Elementary and Theuerkauf Elementary and;

WHEREAS, the Mountain View Whisman School District is participating in the California Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten and Full-Day Kindergarten Facilities Grant Program and intends to apply for and receive funding from the State for new construction and/or retrofit of full-day transitional kindergarten and/or kindergarten classrooms for any or all of the following school sites: Amy Imai Elementary, Benjamin Bubb Elementary, Edith Landels Elementary, Gabriela Mistral Elementary, Jose Antonio Vargas Elementary, Mariano Castro Elementary, Monta Loma Elementary, Stevenson Elementary and Theuerkauf Elementary and;

WHEREAS, the Mountain View Whisman School District now wishes to file an application for funding for these projects with the Office of Public School Construction for approval by the State Allocation Board to appropriate funding for the projects;

WHEREAS, the Mountain View Whisman School District has established a Restricted Routine Maintenance Account for exclusive purpose of providing ongoing and major maintenance of school buildings and has developed an ongoing and major maintenance plan that complies with and is implemented for this purpose; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Board of the Mountain View Whisman School District hereby authorizes the District's Representative(s) to the Office of Public School Construction to file all required documents for funding under Chapter 3, Part 10.5, Division 1, commencing with Section 17375, et seq, of the Education Code.
