Dear Board of Trustees,

Pursuant to Section 15278 of the Education Code, the District established an "independent citizens' oversight committee" to satisfy the accountability requirements of Proposition 39.

Given that the expenditure of Measure G bond funds was nearly complete, through Board Resolution No. 01-060420 the Board discontinued the Measure G CBOC to establish a citizens' oversight committee to oversee the expenditure of remaining Measure G and Measure T bond funds.

The Committee actively reviewed the proper expenditure of taxpayers' money for school construction, and advises the public as to whether the District is in compliance. The Committee convened to provide oversight for, but not limited to, the following:

- Ensuring that Measure G and Measure T bond proceeds are expended only for the purposes described in paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Section 1 of Article XIII A of the California Constitution.
- Ensuring that Measure G and Measure T bond proceeds are not used for any teacher or administrative salaries or other school operating expenses, unless permitted by applicable law.

The committee met in June 2022, August 2022, October 2022, and March 2023. The committee reviewed Measure G and T Expenditure Reports, the breakdown of improvements by project type, overall project summary reports, breakdown by campus, encumbrance summary by project and draft audit. The reports that the committee reviewed are available on the MVWSD website.

In the opinion of the committee, the District is in compliance with the requirements of Article XIII A, Section 1, subdivision (b)(3) of the California Constitution.
