Dear Mayor Showalter, Honorable Council Members, and City Manager

I hope you had a restful and rejuvenating summer. On behalf of the Mountain View Whisman School Board, I am writing to extend an invitation to meet to discuss the Shoreline Regional Park Community Tax District.

We are thankful for your partnership in the past in establishing the Education Enhancement Reserve Joint Powers Authority (EER JPA). Both the Mountain View Whisman and the Mountain View Los Altos school districts rely on property tax revenue from the Shoreline Park District to support our students each and every day.

The Ad Hoc Committee established by the City Council met once in December of 2023. The City proposed a three year extension in the fall, and MVWSD proposed a one year extension in June. Both extensions were temporary solutions while a new successor agreement would be negotiated. The previous one-year extension has now lapsed. We would like to hold a meeting of the Ad Hoc Committee to continue the work toward developing a long term successor agreement together.
