#### **CHAC AGREES TO PROVIDE:**

The Community Health Awareness Council (CHAC) hereby agrees to provide the Mountain View-Whisman School District with advanced counseling services for the 2017-18 school year. Up to two counselors (2.0 FTE) will be on campus for a total of 60 hours each week for approximately 42 weeks 2520 hours total contract. CHAC will provide the counselors with the infrastructure and professional development/supervision required to ensure that students receive highest level of care and support.

## MOUNTAIN VIEW-WHISMAN SCHOOL DISTRICT AGREES TO PROVIDE:

- Pleasant, therapeutic rooms conducive to privacy.
- Basic supplies and access to copy machine (for training manuals, etc.).
- · Code of confidentiality
- Collegial working relationship with district/school mental health services

#### PAYMENT:

CHAC shall submit a quarterly invoice, which lists the services provided. Upon verification, Mountain View-Whisman School District shall pay the invoice within 30 days of receipt.

FEES: \$193,100

# INDEMNITY:

Mountain View-Whisman School District shall indemnify and hold harmless CHAC and its officers, agents and employees from any and all liabilities of any kind for or on account of any suits or damage of any character whatsoever, including injury to person or property, to the extent permitted by law. Likewise, the CHAC shall indemnify and hold harmless Mountain View-Whisman School District and its officers, agents and employees from any and all liabilities of any kind for or on account of any suits or damage of any character whatsoever, including injury to person or property, to the extent permitted by law.

This agreement may be renegotiated for future services, depending upon needs and funding.
