Distance Learning Support

COHORTS

- Based on grade-level & classwork.
- Same RAS Educator every day.
- Strict adherence to RAS/MVW safety procedures.

ACADEMIC & SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL SUPPORT

- Daily check-ins with parents.
- Alignment w/ school & classroom objectives.
- Direct coordination w/ school leaders & teachers when individual questions arise.



Distance Learning Support

BALANCE

- RAS activities and fun fitness breaks throughout the day.
- Help 'get out the wiggles' and keep students motivated & focused.

CONSISTENCY

- RAS schedules will match MVW's daily distance learning plan.
- RAS educators create a daily environment of safety, support, focus, and guidance.

Our Daily Safety Procedures



Wellness Checks

We provide wellness checks for staff and students every day before entering the program. These include temperature-taking and self-assessment for any symptoms. No one is allowed in camp with any symptoms or if there is a sick family member at home.



Hygiene Practices

We adhere to new hygiene practices: handwashing for staff and students for at least 20 seconds multiple times per day (upon arrival, before eating, coming in from outside, after restroom use, etc.).



Physical Distancing

Physical distancing is practiced at all times. Students sit apart during meal times, curriculum activities and outdoor play (playground equipment is not used).



Staff Face Masks

All staff wear protective face masks in the program at all times.



Personal Supply Kits

Students do not share activity supplies; each student has his or her own supply kit.



Sanitization Practices

We have increased sanitization practices: all surfaces and areas are cleaned after each use throughout the day.



Staff to Student Ratios

Staff to student ratios meet or exceed each state's new regulations.

Our Alignment w/ CA =

- Children will wear masks as mandated by the state of California
- No one will be allowed in program outside of staff and enrolled students. Parents will pick up / drop off from outside of the classroom
- We will continue to monitor CDC, state and district guidelines and adjust safety measures as appropriate

Right At School Locations

ALL listed locations include our distance learning support!

- Crittenden Middle School (Up to 60 students)
- District Office Portables (Up to 40 students. Only if Crittenden reaches capacity)

If demand outpaces location capacity, we are able to scale up and work with MVW to identify and open additional locations.

AUGUST 3rd-6th – ESSENTIAL FAMILIES

- Priority registration for essential workers (per CA definition of essential)
- Apply via online form.
- Approved families will receive a direct registration link.

AUGUST 7th – ALL FAMILIES

- Registration open to all families.
- Registration, payment, and scheduling on the same easy-to-use parent portal as our regular programs!
